# February 2017 President's Report



A warm welcome to Jackie Dove, Patricia Gonsalves and Lisa Palmer who were inducted into our Club by Governor Lori Robinson at our January 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting. I am confident that you will find membership in Zonta rewarding as you participate in our efforts to improve the lives of women and girls in our community and worldwide.

Our February 28<sup>th</sup> dinner meeting will be held at the CIBC Breast Assessment Centre and begin with a reception hosted by the Hamilton Health Sciences Foundation. We will be presenting our cheque for \$23,000 to cover the final payment on Zonta's \$200,000 pledge to the new CIBC Breast Assessment Centre. This state-of-the-art centre opened in September 2014 to provide comprehensive, multidisciplinary and leading-edge care in the diagnosis of breast cancer.

This gift is a monumental accomplishment for our Club only made possible through the efforts of every Zontian. It began with a task force identifying this project as a much-needed service for women . It is the largest single gift in our Club's history that has taken us nine golf tournaments to raise.

A special thanks to Sandra Cronk who was instrumental in starting golf tournaments some twenty years ago as a means to raise funds for our Club, and who continues to be the sparkplug in this initiative.

Our Club has once again demonstrated its leadership by making the next focus of our golf tournament fund-raising initiative women's mental illness and addiction. Mental illness is finally coming to the forefront through such campaigns as "Let's Talk" and I am extremely proud that our Club has decided to make this our funding priority in the health of women and girls.

International Women's Day will be held on March 8, 2017 with a campaign theme "Be Bold for Change". We will include a short segment to celebrate International Women's Day at our upcoming Lunafest, Friday, March 3<sup>rd</sup> at the Zoetic Theatre. I encourage all members to help in selling tickets for this event. It is an important fund-raiser for us and gives us an opportunity to increase the profile of Zonta in the community.

Our Service Committee will be presenting the 2016-17 Service Budget at our February 28th business meeting. Please review the budget attached to this edition of Tel-O-Zonta as this item will be voted on at the meeting.

The Zonta Area 1 and 2 Leading the Way Spring Workshop will take place in Stratford on Saturday, April 29<sup>th</sup>.
