January 2017 President's Report



Every January, Zonta celebrates the life of Zontian and famed aviator Amelia Earhart. January 11th is selected as Amelia Earhart Day in recognition of the day Amelia began her solo trip in 1935 from Honolulu Hawaii, to Oakland, California making her the first person to fly solo across any part of the Pacific Ocean.

"Everyone has oceans to fly, if they have the heart to do it. Is it reckless? Maybe. But what do dreams know of boundaries?"

The Amelia Earhart Fellowship was established in 1938 by Zonta International in honor of Amelia Earhart. This fellowship program supports women pursuing a PhD/doctoral degree in aerospace-related sciences or aerospacerelated engineering. Since the program's inception, Zonta has awarded 1,508 Amelia Earhart Fellowships, totalling more than US\$3 million, to 1,079 women from 70 countries. Over the next two years, an additional seventy fellowships valued at US\$10,000 each will be awarded.

There are also a number of firsts by Canadian women in aviation.

Eileen Vollick, fascinated by aviation from childhood, enrolled in a Hamilton, Ontario flying school in March, 1928 at the age of 19. She passed the federal aviation test and became the first Canadian woman to earn a private pilot's certificate. Eileen opened the doors of aviation to Canadian women who would embrace flying careers as licensed pilots.

"Opportunity was calling in a thousand forms, in a new and thrilling and expanding industry-commercial aviation, and I felt the urge to fly, to become a pioneer and blaze the trail for the women in my country."

Elsie MacGill became the first woman in the world to design an airplane and she supervised production of the Hawker Hurricane fighter planes. She graduated in 1929 with a master's degree in aeronautical engineering, becoming the first woman in North America do so. She continued her studies at MIT in Cambridge and received her doctorate in 1934. Elsie was never able to fly herself because she was crippled by polio but she insisted on being a passenger on all test flights. MacGill was active in women's rights issues such as paid maternity leave and the liberalization of abortion laws. She was named to the Royal Commission on the Status of Women in 1967. *"I have received many engineering awards, but I hope I will also be remembered as an advocate for the rights of women and children."*

Dr. Roberta Bondar, Honorary Member of the Zonta Club of Hamilton 1, had a childhood dream of becoming an astronaut. This was realized when Dr. Bondar launched from Earth on January 22, 1992 aboard NASA's space shuttle Discovery as Canada's first woman astronaut and the first neurologist in space.

"Without knowledge the world is bereft of culture. And so we must be educators and students both."

We have an exciting year ahead for our club as our committees continue with their work plans. District 4 Governor Lori Robinson will join us on January 24th and preside over the induction of three new members, Patricia Gonsalves, Jackie Dove and Lisa Palmer. Governor Lori will also be presenting service anniversary certificates. As we have a full program on January 24, I ask that committee reports for the business meeting be submitted in writing.

From the Archives

What The Zonta Club of Hamilton 1 Did with Raised Funds in the early 1990's

The Service Committee is currently reviewing requests from registered volunteer agencies for our raised funds through Bingo and the fund raising committee. I thought you might find it interesting to know where our funds went in the early part of the 1990's.

The VON (Victoria Order of Nurses Hamilton-Wentworth) received a donation from our club in 1993 for \$10,000.00. This donation was an additional amount from a previous amount of \$6,000.00 given to the Day Centre since it opened. A previous donation in 1991, of \$3,000.00 was used to provide a security system as well as vertical blinds for the windows. In March of 1992 our club also donated \$3,000.00 which is being used to develop raised garden beds at the Centre. The garden provides two functions; it helps to beautify the outdoor area and it provides therapy for clients who are able to enjoy outdoor activity.

The \$10,000.00 was used to build a quiet room within the Day Centre. Staff identified a need for a room for clients who could not cope with the general noise and activity of a busy day at the Centre. It was also felt that all clients could benefit from a smaller space that offered an opportunity for quiet relaxation. The "Quiet Room" was constructed in December 1992. The VON Adult Centre (including the quiet room) and the VON Junior League Centre Overnight Respite Centre now provides a facility for those with Dementia and Alzheimer's disease. It has colour coded walls that enable patients to wander in a safe environment.

These highlights are from an article in the "VON NEWS" in the Winter of 1993.
