The stars were aligned on June 7th, the 20th anniversary celebration of our annual golf tournaments, and what a celebration it was. More than \$20,000 was raised for our new funding focus, mental illness and addiction in women and girls.

We take great pride in the fact that \$600,000 was raised and distributed to causes related to breast cancer, and that our \$200,000 pledge to the CIBC Breast Assessment Centre is now complete.

A sincere thank you to all the Zontians who have served on this fund-raising committee over the years and to Sandra Cronk, who spearheaded this effort 20 years ago. Sandra has agreed to continue as Chair of the Golf Tournament Committee next year.

At our June 13th Board meeting, the Board addressed the club's work plan for 2017-18. During the summer months, we intend to conduct a club self-audit. We will be calling on our committee chairs to assist in this initiative and in the development of a longer term strategic plan. This plan will be presented to our members at the September 26th dinner meeting.

We have a busy year ahead of us. Our Birthing Kit Assembly Day is on September 9th, followed by the District 4 Conference in Niagara Falls from September 21 to 24,

2017. Sandra Cronk and Julie Kostal have offered to be our delegates at this conference and Karin Eckart will be the alternate. This is an important activity for our district as we prepare for the 2018 International Convention and International's 100th anniversary in 2019. I hope that some of you are planning to attend this conference.
