

This is the time of year when we celebrate the rewards of our volunteer work and see the impact of Zonta's financial support on the lives of women and their families.

On February 28th at the CIBC Breast Assessment Centre celebration, we were given insight from Carol Rand into the high quality of service being provided to women who go through the breast screening program. This Centre is also one of a handful of facilities offering genetic testing for those with a family history of breast cancer.

Some of us have experienced the trauma of being diagnosed with breast cancer and having to deal with every aspect of this horrible disease, some have mourned the loss of a loved one as a result of breast cancer, others have supported a family member or friend through their period of recovery. However we relate to this disease, let us take pride in the knowledge that our support has made a difference.

On Friday, March 3rd we celebrated our 3rd annual Lunafest, a fun evening of short film presentations by women, for women and about women, and the opportunity to raise funds for our service work, while at the same time enhancing Zonta's profile in the community. This year's event was the most successful to date. We thank Trish Mongeon, her team, and all Zonta members who sold tickets for Lunafest.

On March 28th we will celebrate our individual and collective support of Zonta International service projects. We will receive a progress report from Karin Eckart on some of these service initiatives. We will celebrate our local support when Kathy Kingsmill and the members of our Service Committee present our donation cheques to a number of this year's grant recipients.

I want to thank Kathy and the members of this committee for their time and effort in assessing the grant applications and recommending programs for support that will truly have an impact on women and girls in our local community. We have once again partnered with the United Way of Burlington and Greater Hamilton by responding to ArcelorMittal Dofasco's Employee Donations Fund Challenge. \$34,000 of Zonta's 2016-17 grants will be made through the United Way and as such matched dollar for dollar by the Employee Donations Fund. This is a win-win for our club and the community at large. By leveraging our gift in this way more funds are generated for much-needed program support.

Over the past twenty years, we have participated in matching fund programs that generated an additional \$180,000 for various organizations. We have much to celebrate.

Nominating Committee


