

March 2015 President's Report



I am writing this on International Women's Day, a day when we celebrate the courage and determination of women around the world advocating for gender equality. Congratulations go also to Rosita Hall, of the Zonta Club of Hamilton 2, for receiving the Legacy of Merit Award at the annual Illuminescence Gala today.

On Zonta International's Facebook page, there is an interesting bit of history. In 1995, 47,000 people streamed into Beijing for the Fourth World Conference on Women with a single purpose in mind: gender equality and the empowerment of all women, everywhere. The conference gave birth to the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action, the most progressive blueprint ever for advancing women's rights. This March, people around the world will mark the 20th International Women's Day since the landmark agreement. The 59th Session of the Commission on the Status of Women (9-20 March 2015) will review progress made in the implementation of the Declaration and Platform for Action, including current challenges affecting its implementation and the achievement of gender equality and the empowerment of women. More than 70 Zontians will be participating in this year's CSW in New York.

I mentioned in a recent report that the Ebola epidemic had halted the ZI Liberia project. So I was happy to see on the ZI Facebook page that, following a significant reduction in the incidence of Ebola in Liberia, the Liberia Fistula Project, a partnership between Zonta International and UNFPA, resumed full scale operations in December.

Looking forward to the March meeting, where we will receive an update on our strategic planning goals and gear up to move forward with our action plans to make this a great biennium! Thanks to all of you for bringing this to life! I hope you are saving the date for the Zonta Spring Workshop in Woodstock on April 25th. See you soon.
