Advocacy

As we approach International Women's Day or Zonta Rose Day on March 8th there is much to be excited about regarding women's equality but also much to do.

The World Economic Forum has published a ranking of 145 countries in regards to their accomplishments towards achieving Gender Equality. Iceland has ranked #1 for 7 consecutive years. Interestingly enough they 'have had a female head of state for 20 of the past 50 years'. The country has 'closed the educational gender gap and ranks first for political empowerment'.

The other countries in the Top Ten in order are as follows: Norway, Finland, Sweden, Ireland, Rwanda, Philippines, Switzerland, Slovenia and New Zealand. In a great number of these countries, more than 30% of their elected representatives are women. The United States and Canada both obtained the same rating and the US is in at #28 and Canada is at #30. For more information about the report please go to www.weforum.org.
