From the Hamilton Spectator January 17, 1959

Amelia Earhart Day was commemorated at the Zonta Club of Hamilton meeting this week.

A resume of the life of this world-famous air pioneer was given by Mrs. S.F. Brittan. A new member, Mrs. Robert Heaslip was introduced to the club by Miss Lillian Larmour and installed by Mrs. Fred Cloke. Arrangements were completed for the World Day of Prayer Evening Service which is being held on February 13 at 8 o'clock in Centenary United Church, Hamilton, the Zonta Club being in charge of the evening service.

From the Hamilton Spectator June 26, 1958

Mrs. Margaret Marshall and Mrs. Louise Hicks opened their home on Lake Shore Blvd Burlington for the Final meeting of this season of the Zonta Club of Hamilton. The annual affair took the usual of a picnic supper to which several guests were welcomed as well as members. Miss Jean Sleeth and Mrs. Margaret Marshall president and past president of Zonta gave reports. They announced that Hamilton Zonta Club would have major responsibilities when the next international convention will be held in Toronto in 1960.
