Dear Zonta Sisters,

I'm writing this on a dreary February day that brings all kinds of challenges along with it! Trying to walk or drive and staying warm outside proves to be difficult! It is weather conducive to reading and reflection.

In a recent NY Times article entitled <u>Girls Get Tech. They just need others to believe it</u>. Research done by the Girl Scout Research Institute in the US indicated, through a survey of 2,900 girls and boys ages 5 to 17 (along with their parents) how access to smartphones, tablets, laptops and gaming devices helps put girls on par with boys when it comes to tech or exceed them in some respects. Here are the highlights:

- Boys play games for fun, while girls use tech to learn.
- Boys remain more confident in their skills.
- Parents give sons more digital freedom.
- The future is bright (if we intervene at the right moment). "By teaching our girls to code, we're not just preparing them to enter the work force we're preparing them to lead it," Reshma Saujani, chief executive of Girls Who Code, said last year
