# September 2019 President's Report



Dear Zonta Sisters,

Since I have spent my career in education, I always view September as a beginning, albeit without champagne! At the club level we are in the process of creating committees and a plan to make our club vibrant and visible in our community.

On Friday August 23rd I had a very positive meeting with the YWCA, specifically with Denise Christopherson and Sarah Ernest, regarding the Olga Cloke Bursary. In our discussion I also indicated the YWPA Award does not get the publicity it deserves. The YWCA is now going to present the Cloke Bursary at the Totally Awesome Young Women's Breakfast (TAYWB) in May. About 500 girls from Hamilton High Schools are invited and attend this and the YW does all the publicity and organizing around the event. It is intended that the applications for the Cloke and the YWPA be sent out with the info for the TAYWB. Our club will also be invited to the breakfast to present the Olga Cloke Award.

D4 Foundation Ambassadors Kathy Smith and Lori Robinson sent a note to thank us for the contributions our club has made to the Zonta International Foundation. Our treasurer, Maureen Hayman submitted \$2890 to Zonta International — \$2000 for International Service Fund, \$300 for Amelia Earhart Fellowship Fund, \$500 for ZISVAW Fund and an additional \$90 to the ZISVAW Fund in honour of St. Catharines Club's 90th Anniversary.

I am looking forward to the District Conference in Buffalo, especially since our club nomination of Dr. Beverly Jacobs for the Canadian Zonta Centennial Award produced the winner! She will attend the conference in Buffalo on Saturday September 28th to receive the certificate from Zonta International. I hope our club will also be able to honour her appropriately later, perhaps at the December 10<sup>th</sup> meeting - which also happens to be "Human Rights Day".

Preparations for Birthing Kit Assembly Day are well underway. Renate Davidson reports that there are 45 volunteers registered!!! Wow!

Committee members are still being confirmed. So far Dianne Moore would like to concentrate on Awards with Kathy Kingsmill Marsales; Judy Lindsay will stay on as Service Committee Chair and Alice Tyler will join this committee. We also need a few other volunteers to help Liz Newman at the door at dinner meetings. Please let me know where you can help out and/or if you would like a change. It has also been suggested that the Fellowship and Membership Committees merge—our numbers are down.

Recruitment is everyone's role in Zonta. As a recruiter it is your job to match the potential member's need to the solution that Zonta can deliver. Be prepared with possible questions you can ask to "understand" how you can best match the individual's desires and needs with your Zonta club experience. Walk the prospective member up the path: Give them an experience such as volunteering to assemble clean birth kits; attending a dinner meeting or Lunafest, understand their needs and show them how Zonta can fulfil their needs and how in turn they can help women and girls in the world.
