I hope to have the club look at itself through a lens of Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion as we move forward. In doing so we will be able to grow and sustain our membership and grow our outreach in our community and globally.

#### June is Indigenous History Month and Pride Month.

This artwork, which blends the symbols of both commemorations, was in a post from SACHA (Sexual Assault Centre of Hamilton and Area) and I thought that it was a good message for Zontians.

Two of Zonta's causes are "Ending Gender-Based Violence" and "Advocating for Gender Equality". Zontians need to remember that these gender-framed goals apply to <u>all</u> women and women-identified persons. Many queer and trans women are not acknowledged as women and are denigrated because of this. The incidence of gender-based violence is much higher against Indigenous women and queer and trans women.

SACHA says that "the work to end violence must be rooted in decolonization, Indigenization and Indigenous sovereignty and queer and trans liberation. Indigenous and/or two-spirit and LGBTQIA+ people have

had to be resilient for so long and deserve so much more than a month of awareness and solidarity. Justice and safety are not enough. They deserve to thrive, now, as their whole selves, and on their own terms.
